For the last five years Adam has exhibited contemporary garden furniture at the Chelsea Flower Show, combining the reclaimed timbers Nightingale & Son is renowned for, with stone, polished concrete, stainless steel and glass.

Chelsea 2005

Chelsea 2005 sees Nightingale & Son share a stand with Natural Driftwood Sculptures. The recovered cedar is a common theme in both companies, from the modern furniture to the naturally sculpted driftwood.

Product launch

In addition to this year's new garden table designs, Nightingale & Son and Natural Driftwood Sculptures will be show casing a new design that combines cedar and stainless steel fittings, to make a modular garden structure that is easy to assemble.

"My idea is to produce a contemporary garden pergola/arbour, using recovered cedar, that is as functional as it is beautiful and can be designed to meet the individual customer's needs, whether for dinner parties on a roof terrace in London or to grow your climber on," says Adam Nightingale.
